How to leave a gift in your Will?

If you don't yet have a Will **OR** If you already have a Will

You might like to leave us:

- 01 A specific amount (Pecuniary gift)
- 02 The residue of your estate (Residuary gift)
- 03 A specific gift

If you already have a Will and you wish to now leave a legacy to Amnesty International, you can easily update it with a codicil.

We recommend that whether you are thinking of making a new Will or updating an existing one with a codicil, you consult a solicitor. They will make sure your Will is valid and that your intentions are clearly and legally stated.



Suggested Wording for your Will

01

A specific amount (Pecuniary gift)

I give to Amnesty International Hong Kong Section Human Rights Education Charitable Trust of Unit 3D, Best-O-Best Commercial Centre, 32-36 Ferry Street, Kowloon, Hong Kong HK\$_____ to be used for its general charitable purposes. I further direct that the receipt of the secretary, treasurer or other officers of Amnesty International Hong Kong Section for the time being shall be a full and sufficient discharge of the said legacy.

02

The residue of your estate (Residuary gift)

I give to Amnesty International Hong Kong Section Human Rights Education Charitable Trust of Unit 3D, Best-O-Best Commercial Centre, 32-36 Ferry Street, Kowloon, Hong Kong _____ % the residue of my estate to be used for its general charitable purposes. I further direct that the receipt of the secretary, treasurer or other officers of Amnesty International Hong Kong Section for the time being shall be a full and sufficient discharge of the said legacy.

Suggested Wording for your Will

A specific gift

I give to Amnesty International Hong Kong Section Human Rights Education Charitable Trust of Unit 3D, Best-O-Best Commercial Centre, 32-36 Ferry Street, Kowloon, Hong Kong _____
(the description of property or assets given) to be used for its general charitable purposes. I further direct that the receipt of the secretary, treasurer or other officers of Amnesty International Hong Kong Section for the time being shall be a full and sufficient discharge of the said legacy.
